Introduction

- Goal is to introduce the research project to your audience and draw the reader in (Start with a story!!)
- Gives context of the research
- Gives necessary background information
- Explains why your project is important (vaguely)
- Usually, the last sentence is the thesis statement (the main idea of your paper)
- Structure, length and content depend on discipline and research (and mentor)
- 1. Why do we need an introduction?
- 2. What do we want to include?
- 3. What should we not include?

<u>Style considerations</u> - The reader doesn't want to read everything you know about a subject. Present background information *only as needed* in order to support a position.
