The Founders is an iconic story of thirteen women - including Minnesota legend Patty Berg - who together battled society, prejudice, and preconception to create a lasting, global sporting legacy in golf. While their male counterparts drew adoring crowds and handsome purses for their athletic achievements, The Founders used money from their own pockets to stage tournaments in small, far-flung towns that questioned whether female golfers were even worth watching. Together, they logged thousands of miles a week just for the opportunity to tee off on courses they also had to groom! With the creation of the Ladies Professional Golf Association, The Founders staked their claim on the green and forged a path for future women athletes to be celebrated and taken seriously.

The Tucker Center Film Festival celebrates films that feature women's sport and female athletes and is one of more than 1,000 events taking place across the country for National Girls and Women in Sport Day.
